At the start of 2025, Falcon West strengthened its long-standing relationship with the sport of rugby by launching a formal, paid Academy internship program. The Academy was developed to provide professional athletes with a structured "off-the-pitch" career path. Bart Vermuelen

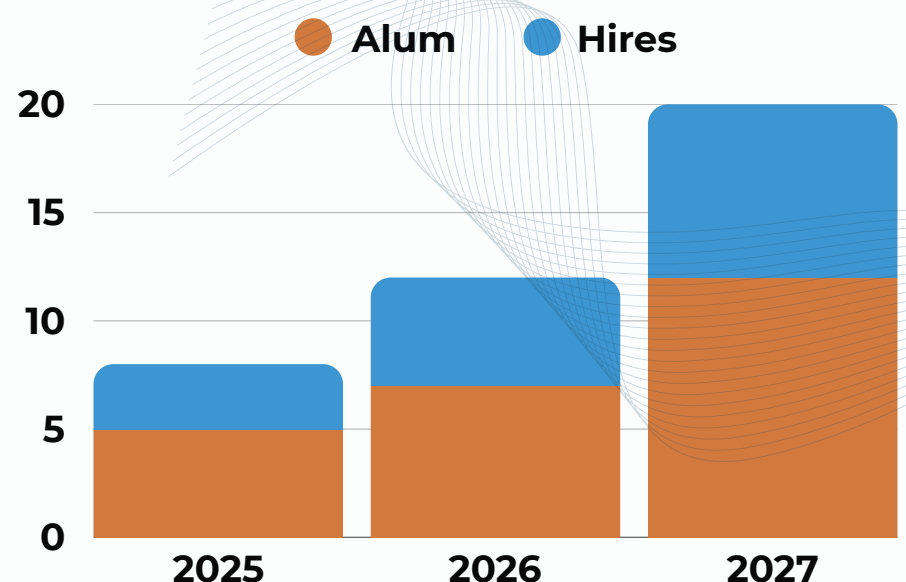
Leading our internal AI infrastructure and deployment. Playing for Old Glory for the 2026 Season.

Looking Ahead

Our commitment to supporting rugby players develop professionally off the pitch remains a core pillar of our social impact and recruitment strategy. Based on this year's proof of concept, which produced 8 participants and 3 full-time hires, we are positioned to scale our impact. **We project growth to 12 participants and 5 hires in 2026**, reaching 20 participants and 8 hires by 2027. By investing in these athletes off the pitch, we are building a resilient, high-performance workforce for the future, as well as providing a proven and rewarding career path for high achievers.
